Last month, we had another very successful Fall Ticket Book Sale. This year, we shortened the sale period to two weeks, compared to the previous three-week sale. Despite the shorter timeline, we surpassed our goal of \$10.7 million. By the end of our grace period, total sales reached nearly \$12 million!

We also saw great results from our Black Friday–Travel Tuesday promotion. Our promo code for single tickets was used on 129 bookings, generating \$184,864.50 in revenue. Additionally, we brought in additional \$490,905 from ticket book sales, totaling \$675,769.50 in revenue generated from both initiatives over our fiveday sale.

# Safety Newsletter: Safety is a Habit, Not a Location

The holiday season is a time for joy and celebration, but it also brings unique safety challenges — both at home and at work. Let's make sure we keep ourselves, our families, and our colleagues safe during this festive time. Safety doesn't happen by chance—it's a habit we build every day. Whether you're at home or at work, make safety part of everything you do. Stay alert, stay prepared, and stay safe!

# Safety at Home During the Holidays

## **Fire Safety**

- ·Keep Christmas trees away from heat sources.
- ·Water live trees regularly to prevent drying.
- •Never leave candles unattended; consider batteryoperated alternatives.

# Kitchen Safety

- •Never leave cooking unattended—it's the #1 cause of home fires.
- ·Keep flammable items away from stovetops.
- ·Keep a fire extinguisher nearby & know how to use it.

#### **Electrical Safety**

- ·Inspect holiday lights for frayed wires or broken bulbs.
- ·Avoid overloading outlets and use surge protectors.
- •Turn off decorations when leaving home or going to bed. A programable timer or smart plug works great.

#### **Ladder Safety**

- ·Use a sturdy ladder when hanging decorations, indoors or outside.
- ·Always maintain three points of contact.
- ·Never stand on furniture to reach high places.

# Safety at Work During the Holidays

#### Mental Health & Fatigue

- •The holidays can be stressful, take breaks and manage your workload.
- •Stay hydrated as much during the winter as you do during the warmer months.
- ·Homemade holiday sweets in the office can be fun to share. Snack in moderation to avoid the afternoon sugar crash!

#### Cold and Flu Season

- •Spreading cold and flu germs is easy. All it takes is a cough, a sneeze, or an unwashed hand touching a door handle or stair railing
- •Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you sneeze. If no tissue is handy, cough or sneeze into the inner part of your sleeve at the elbow.
- ·If you get a flu-like illness, consider staying at home away from others for at least 24 hours after the fever is gone.

#### **Parking Lot Considerations**

- ·Wear boots or shoes with nonslip soles and good ankle support. If necessary, carry your work shoes with you and change inside. Keep an eye out snow and ice melt on floors.
- •When walking in an icy lot (or any lot for that matter) make eye contact with an approaching driver. Stop if you don't think the driver has seen you.
- Rain and inclement weather can muffle engine sounds; don't rely solely on hearing to know if a vehicle is coming. Electric and hybrid vehicles are especially quiet.
